Here's an update on the arbitration case involving food service members being made to hold and maintain a managerial license that was not in their job description which changed the condition of employment for them. This was based on a Mandate that the District said was new, but it was not nor had the requirement for this Mandate changed. The District has recently agreed to sit down and bargain with USW a resolve to this violation. While this is great news, it is also the first step towards a resolution.

However, this is definitely headed in the right direction!

THE MORE YOU KNOW . . .

Article VII, Personnel File and Employee Protection

D. Employee may attach letters of disagreement or rebuttal to any evaluation which is placed in the employee's personnel file.

While it is early for a lot of us, employee evaluations are currently going on in some buildings and I have been getting questions on what to do if a member feels they have received a negative or poor review that is not true or accurate.

Most of our member evaluations are fair, however if this does happen to you, you have the right to write a letter or rebuttal explaining why you feel the evaluation is unfair. Once this is done, staple your letter to the evaluation you were given (always make a copy) and take it to the Board Office and HR secretary, Angie O'Brien. Angie will then make sure the evaluation with your rebuttal is placed in your permanent personnel file where it will remain.
