ARTICLE IV, Section 5. No member shall be eligible for election as a Local Union Officer or Grievance Committee member unless:

- (a) The member shall have been in continuous good standing for the period of 24 months immediately preceding the month in which the election is held; and
- (b) The member is employed in an enterprise, public or private, or other place within the jurisdiction of the Local Union; and
- In order to be eligible for election as a (c) Officer or Grievance Local Union Committee Member in any regular election or election to fill a vacancy, a member shall have attended at least onethird (1/3) of the regular meetings held by the member's Local Union during the twenty-four (24) month period immediately preceding the month in which the election is held. Note: Local 105 will have held 18 meetings in the 24 month period requiring a minimum of 6 to be attended.

Meetings which a member was prevented from attending because of such member's Union activities, working hours, service in the armed forces of the United States or Canada, sickness which confines, death in the immediate family, or jury duty, shall not be counted as meetings held in determining such member's eligibility under this Section; provided, that the member shall have the burden of proving inability to attend for one of the prescribed reasons in accordance with procedures specified in the Local Union elections Manual.

ARTICLE IV, Section 10.

Any member nominated as a candidate must notify the Financial Secretary of the Local Union in writing of the acceptance. Such acceptance shall be personally delivered or mailed to the Financial

Secretary by registered or certified mail postmarked no later than 2400 hours of the 5th day following nominations. In absence of the Financial Secretary, written acceptances presented to an Executive Board Officer within the five day requirement shall be deemed sufficient notification. Unexcused failure to notify the Financial Secretary of the Local Union in the prescribed time will be an automatic disqualification for candidacy.
