## **USW ERT HELPS MEMBERS AND FAMILIES**

The United Steelworkers Emergency Response Team investigates all catastrophic injuries and workplace fatalities involving USW members and assists their families and co-workers. The goal of the USW ERT is to help victims, family members, and anyone else that needs assistance as well as to investigate, find, and fix the hazards in the workplace. Each district has 3-5 ERT Coordinators that help when an injury occurs. We have 2 of them in District 11 from Local 105. Mike Nicholas started working with the ERT in 2008, and Rob Reid joined in 2018.

We recently had a workplace accident that injured a fellow Steelworker at our facility. We know there are a lot of questions about his condition. While he is making improvements, right now we do not have a lot of answers due to respecting the families' privacy. We have reached out to offer our help and support for anything they need, and we will continue to do so.

## **Arconic DPW is looking for Referrals**
