The Beginning History of Local 307:

In 1945, United Rubber, Cork, Linoleum and Plastic Workers of America chartered the employees of the Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company as Local 307 URW. Shortly after that in 1946 the big four rubber companies conceded and 18.8 cent per hours general was increase. But also gained six paid holidays. Local 307 at that time had not secured a contract with Goodyear, but was awarded these benefits as members of the URW. By 1947 the first contract for secured by URW Local 307. The right to bargain, the grievance procedure (including arbitration), One week of vacation after one year of service; and two weeks of vacation after five years of service; three weeks of vacation after 15 years; eleven and one-half cents per hour general wage increase were guaranteed. The company wide contract was settled February of 1947.

27th Annual George C. Amis Memorial Scholarships

The George C. Amis scholarship provides four separate scholarships this year to the sons and daughters of our USW Local 307 member's. These scholarships are for continued education after High school and will be awarded in the amount of \$1,250 to the two chosen from each category.

College student– College students attending a higher education institution in the fall of this year.

Skilled trade student– Current student of a higher education institute, returning in the fall of this year.

Scholarship Rules:

1.) Applicants must be a member or have a parent or legal guardian who is a member of USW Local 307, AFL-CIO.

2.) Applicant must be either entering into a higher education institute for the fall semester of this year, or returning to a higher education institution and must be enrolled as a full time student.


