
We will have employees from Plate Mill moving to the Ingot Plant and Rolling departments. Possible 3 to the Labs depending on recalls to Rolling from the Labs.

lowa residents

1. For lowa residents who choose to vote, the Company will follow State of



Iowa laws that pertain to employee voting.
