2021 SAM BIANCO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

On behalf of the Greater Wilkes-Barre Labor Council, it gives me a great deal of pleasure to announce the creation of the Sam Bianco Memorial Scholarship. The scholarship is named after the late Sam Bianco who served as District Manager of the Pittston and Wyoming Valley International Ladies Garment Workers Union and as President of the Greater Wilkes-Barre Labor Council for over 30 years. He is known as a local union icon who tirelessly championed the causes of working men and women on a local, state and national level.

The labor council is proud to announce this scholarship, designed to financially help young deserving dependent children of union members, whose union is in good standing and affiliated with the Greater Wilkes-Barre Labor Council.

Three scholarships will be awarded this year (one towards a future four-year accredited college attendee, one towards a future community college attendee and one towards a future technical or vocational post-secondary school attendee.) Rules, eligibility and procedures regarding applying for the scholarship are enclosed, which you are free to duplicate. Since this is the first time our labor council is awarding the scholarships, I hope you can help publicize and promote its availability among your membership.

SAM BIANCO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM Sponsored by Greater Wilkes-Barre Labor Council In Memory of Sam Bianco

Three scholarships will be awarded each year. One for \$1,500 to an applicant who will attend an accredited four-year college; one for \$750 to an applicant who will attend a community college; and one for \$750 to an applicant who will attend a technical or vocational post-secondary school. The competition is open to all dependent children of any union member, whose union is affiliated with and in good standing with the Greater Wilkes-Barre Labor Council. For each scholarship winner, the Greater Wilkes-Barre Labor Council will deposit their scholarship amount directly to the school/institution the award recipient will be attending.

RULES & PROCEDURES

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. Applicant must currently be a high school senior, who is a legal dependent (child, stepchild, or grandchild) of a union member, whose union is affiliated with the Greater Wilkes-Barre Labor Council. Those having attained a certified G.E.D. will also be eligible.
- Applicant must be planning to enter a four-year accredited college, community college, technical or vocational post-secondary school for the first time. Those who are currently attending or who have already attended college, technical or vocational school are Not Eligible.
- 3. Those applying to an accredited four year or community college, must take at least 12 credits and be considered a full-time student.
- 4. Those applicants who are fully funded for tuition, fees and books from other sources are Not Eligible.
- 5. Applicants must complete and return an Official Application Form to the Greater Wilkes-Barre Labor Council, by the deadline date of June 15th, specified on the application.
- 6. Applicants are required to type, or hand write an essay of no less than 500 words and no more than 750 words in English on the subject/topic specified on the enclosed Essay Form. Essay must accompany the applicant's Official Application Form and adhere to the deadline date of June 15th for submission.
- 7. Applications can be obtained by contacting the union affiliated with the applicant's parent/legal guardian; the Greater Wilkes-Barre Labor Council's office at 315-317 N. - 1. ON SEPARATE PAPER, PLEASE TYPE OR LEGIBLY WRITE IN ENGLISH AN ESSAY OF AT LEAST 500 WORDS, BUT NOT EXCEEDING 750 WORDS ON THE FOLLOWING TOPIC:
 - "BRIEF HISTORY OF UNIONS (LABOR MOVEMENT) IN NORTHEASTERN PENNSYLVANIA"
- REFERENCE AT THE END OF ESSAY ALL RESOURCE MATERIALS YOU USED/RESEARCHED, IN COMPOSING YOUR ESSAY. THIS CAN INCLUDE WRITTEN DOCUMENTS OR INDIVIDUALS YOU SPOKE TO
- 3. PLEASE SIGN AND DATE YOUR ESSAY AT THE VERY END
- 4. YOUR ESSAY WILL BE EVALUATED ON YOUR PERSONAL OR RESEARCHED KNOWLEDGE YOU ACQUIRED ON THE TOPIC.
- 5. YOUR GRAMMAR, STYLE, ORGANIZATION, REASONING AND PRESENTATION WILL ALSO BE EVALUATED.
- 6. YOUR ESSAY MUST ACCOMPANY YOUR OFFICIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AND BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN THE DEADLINE LATE SPECIFIED.
- 7. ALL DEADLINES ARE STRICTLY ENFORCED. ANY APPLICATION WHICH IS INCOMPLETE OR NOT POSTMARKED ON TIME WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
