President Jerry Redington called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The roll call of officers was taken. All were present except for Leo Patterson.

The minutes from the February meeting were approved as read. March minutes were not available.

At the March meeting it was decided to continue to wear masks but since then the mask mandate from the state has been lifted. Once you are on Medicare you will be placed on Freedom Blue for your insurance from Goodyear. Others on the Titan VEBA and Medicare eligible will only have a reimbursement through Titan VEBA.
