Conference Agenda

The program will include speakers with extensive experience in organizing. Additionally, participants will hear from other recently organized USW members to get a firsthand perspective on organizing campaigns.

Conference participants will:

- Learn how to analyze a bargaining unit and form organizing committees that represent workplace demographics;
- Strategize on how to recruit members to form an active internal organizing committee to achieve 100% membership within the bargaining unit;
- Practice conversational techniques to engage fellow members and spark union activism;
- Develop a practical and effective new hire orientation;
- · Understand how to consistently engage members through social media; and
- Create an action plan so that skills and information learned at the conference can be immediately applied at your Local.

Conference Applications

Classes will be kept small in order to maximize hands-on learning. Therefore, attendance will be limited and participants will be selected based on applications submitted.

We invite you to nominate one member to attend in order to learn the skills and tools for strengthening internal organizing programs. We encourage you to nominate a member who represents the demographics of the workplace that will be organized, and have the motivation and capabilities to apply the skills learned at the conference.
