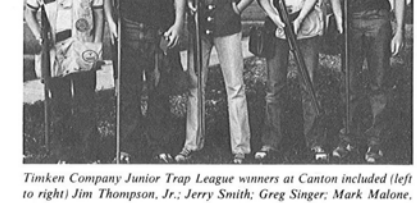

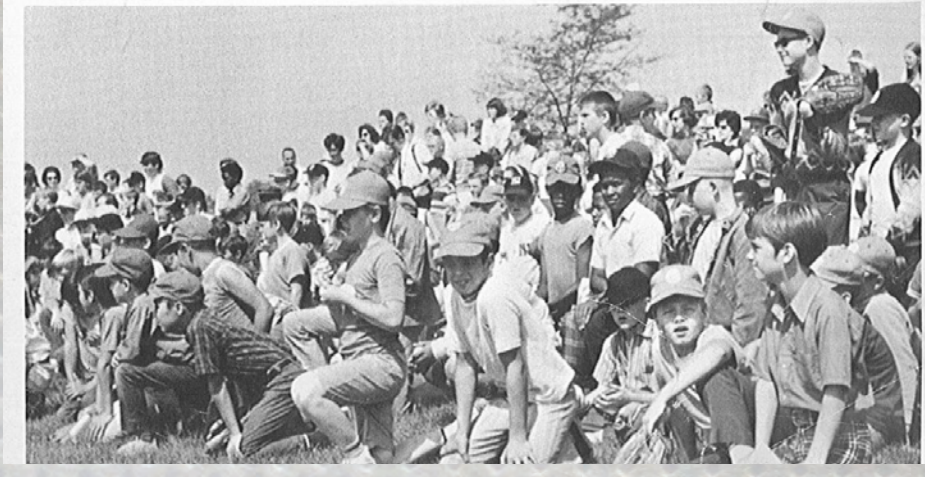

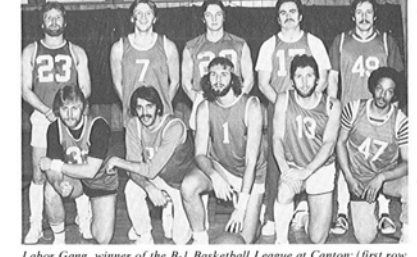

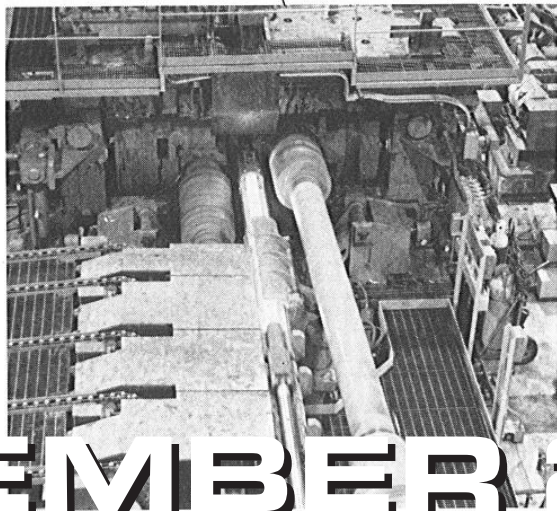


The heart of the new \$23.5 million Number 5 Tube Mill is its rotary hearth furnace. The oil or gas-fired furnace is capable of heating steel billets to temperatures in excess of 1027°C. Depending on size, billets are cycled within the furnace from one to three hours until they reach a red-hot stage.

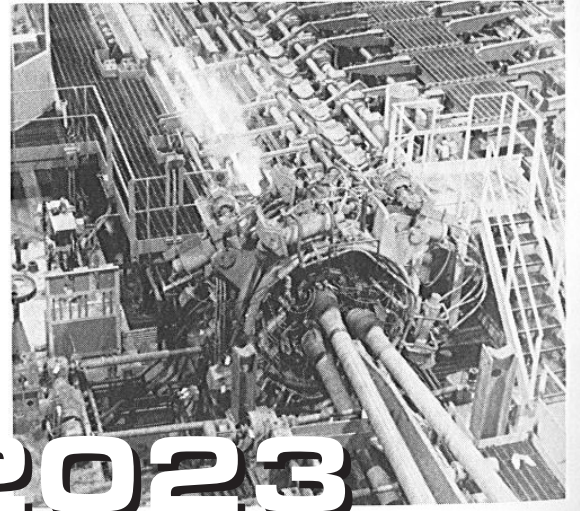
Seamless steel tubing is rolled to precise outside diameter sizes in a 10-stand reducing mill at the new Number 5 Tube Mill. The reducing mill is designed specially to handle a rapid change of tube sizes being rolled at the new facility.
