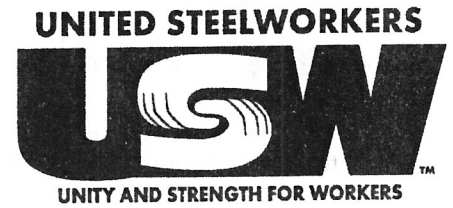

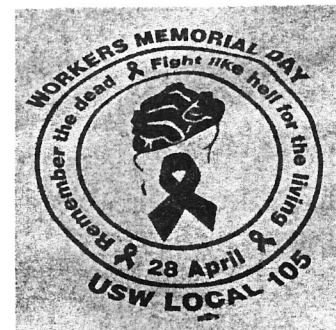

Deferral and Re-enrollment

If you have other health care coverage, you may elect to defer participation in the Retiree Health Care Plan and avoid the required premium payment. If your family status or coverage from another source changes, you may enroll (or re-enroll) in the Plan immediately upon notice and payment of the applicable premium.

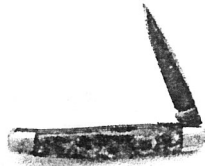
If you elect to defer participation in the Plan, you will be given the opportunity to enroll (or re-enroll) in the Plan during the next annual enrollment period.

If you withdraw from the Plan or your coverage is terminated for failure to make the required premium contribution, you will be allowed to enroll (or re-enroll) in the Plan after six months without coverage under the Plan.
