Attention: Medicare Retirees & Spouses

Part B Reimbursement

On April 6, 2018 Arconic mailed you a letter informing you that "ACTION NEEDED" by June 6, 2018. You must submit proof of enrollment in Medicare Part B in order to avoid having the Medicare Part B reimbursement you receive to be treated as taxable income. The eligibility for Medicare Part B reimbursement is for those retirees that hired in before June 1, 2006.

PRE 1993 Retirees – Part B Reimbursement

If you or your spouse incurred an increase in your Medicare Part B premium for 2018, the retiree should have received a letter from Arconic informing them what to submit in order to get the full Medicare Part B reimbursement on their pension check. You must submit the required documentation by May 1, 2018 to have the reimbursement amounts adjusted retroactively back to January 2018.

Attention: 2018 Retirees

If you believe you experienced a hearing loss due to your employment at Arconic, the new procedure is to contact Liberty Mutual at 800-362-0000 and request to start a new claim.
