Thank you to all who cared enough to participate in our democratic process by voting, by nominating a worthy candidate, by becoming a qualified candidate and being willing to serve as a representative, and by actually serving in these sometimes thankless positions. For those who want to serve or get involved that didn't get elected or meet the qualifications to run for election there are many ways to actively contribute: By attending business meetings, by serving as a union steward or union safety star points, or by serving on a committee such as Rapid Response, Women of Steel, Civil Rights, or Next Generation.

What all does it take to be eligible to run for an office in your local union? You must be a member in good standing for the period 24 months immediately preceding the month in which the election is held. An eligible candidate must have attended at least one third (1/3) of the regular monthly business meetings held by the member's Local Union during the twenty -

four (24) month period immediately preceding the month in which the election is held. Please keep these requirements in mind if you would like to run for an elected officer position in 2021.
