## USW D\&D-FBP CBA Negotiations

## Company's Best and Final Offer (BAFO)

August 1, 2023

After conclusion of negotiations discussions between FBP (Company), and the USW, Local 689 (Union), the Company hereby provides the following BAFO. The Company believes this offer addresses the issues and requires that this offer be supported by the full Union Committee and be put to a ratification vote on or before October 31, 2023.

Note that ALL the following provisions are conditioned upon ratification of the CBA on the first vote Failure to gain ratification by that date will result in this offer being revised or withdrawn.

1. The attached Addendum will be added to the existing collective bargaining agreement to extend the agreement until March 28, 2024.
2. The wages, as noted in Appendix $A$ - Wage Schedule of the CBA Addendum, will be increased to $2 \%$ and will be effective upon ratification, retroactive to March 29, 2023.
3. A one-time signing bonus of $\$ 1,500$, less taxes, contingent upon immediate acceptance of this offer and ratification on the first vote but no later than October 31, 2023, will be provided to each active member of the Unit with in 30 days of ratification, in appreciation of the good faith bargaining process that has resulted in this collective bargaining agreement for the Unit.
