THE MORE YOU KNOW . . .

Applying for a different job within FSD145

Now is the time of year where you start a job but find out it may not be for you, or a new position opens up for a job you have always wanted to try. What is the procedure for a classified staff member who would like to change positions?

Our contract states:

"All present employees will be given first consideration for appointment. All current employees meeting the minimum qualifications of the vacant position and submitting an application to fill the vacant position will be given an interview. Selection will be based upon the consideration of factors that include without limitation certifications, qualifications, merit and ability, seniority, and relevant experience."

What does this mean? It means if you fill out an application for a different job and you are already an employee of the District, you are guaranteed an interview. Even though you are guaranteed an interview, you are not guaranteed the position. While things like seniority and experience can benefit you in an interview, the District still has the right to hire whomever they want.
