This is where being a union member comes into play. If we weren't unionized, RR para positions could have been riffed this school year and those paras forced into Specialized Para positions. There would not be anything you could do to stop it. By being union, we were able to sit down with the District, work together, and keep your jobs safe. It was mutually agreed that all current RR para positions are safe for as long as you want you remain in that

position, so do not worry if you hear otherwise.

AMRP BENEFIT

This is a topic I bring up frequently and it always surprises me how many members do not utilize this benefit. If you work 5 or more hours each school day, do not receive District offered health insurance, and have been working at least six months you are eligible to be reimbursed for medical care (health, dental, vision, chiro, etc.) of \$1000 per plan year. Our plan year runs September-August, and this month \$1000 was put in an account for you through Northern Illinois Health Plan. Also, any portion of the unused \$1000 by the employee **does** roll over to the following year. Some of you may have quite the accumulation of funds in your account!

Something new with this benefit is the "FSA Store." This is an online store you can shop at to purchase things using your AMRP money. This would be used the same way as other claims. You would purchase items from the store and then submit it for reimbursement. The website to check out the store is https://fsastore.com

If you are unsure of your available balance, contact Northern Illinois Health Plan at 815-599-7050. Also, if your school does not have the forms needed to submit claims for reimbursement, email me and I will send you the form. Remember this is a benefit you lose if you quit or retire so utilize the store to use up any extra money if you are thinking of retiring or leaving the District, and turn in receipts for reimbursement. This is your money and your benefit, utilize it and don't lose it!
