Regarding: Issues related to nomination/ballot eligibility for the April 26th, 2018 election

On Monday March 25th, 2018 the E-Board requested the Election Committee to make a decision regarding several items related to nomination/ballot eligibility.

We initially consulted with the National Labor Relations Board and USW Local 689 legal counsel regarding interpretation of the applicable regulations, by-laws, etc., and were then further directed to discuss these issues with USW International Local Union Services.

After careful consideration the Election Committee reached the following conclusions.

- 1. The requirement for all nominees to attend at 1/3 of the local union meeting over the last 24 months will be waived for this election (Local By-laws, Article IV, section 5.c).
- 2. No one individual may run for more than (1) one Full Time position (past practice).
 - a. For purposes of this decision the P&T Unit Vice President is considered Full Time.
- 3. If an individual failed to accept or decline a ballot nomination(s) by the deadline, then they will be placed on the ballot by default (past practice).
 - a. If they were nominated for more than one position, then they will be placed on the ballot in the highest position they were nominated for.
 - b. The highest position will be determined via order listed in Local By-laws. Article IV, sec 1.
- 4. No individual may run for more than one E-board position (Local By-laws, Article IV, section 1 & 2)
 - a. For purposes of this limitation, the P&T Unit Vice President is considered to be included in this list.

A listing of those nominees that will be effected by these decisions will be provided to Barbara Dixon, USW Local 689 Office Manager so that the 2018 ballots can be finalized.
