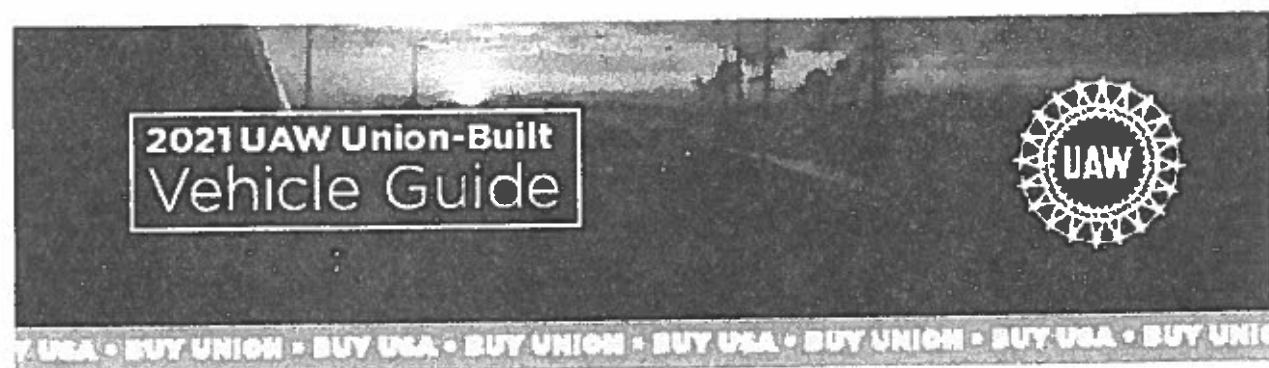
Tax preparation services are available between Jan. 26 and April 15, and include drop-off tax preparation also by appointment.

Tax Time Information

For those of you that took a disbursement out of your 401K during the 2020 tax year, and it qualifies for the Corona-Virus related or 2020 disaster distribution, you may have to fill out form 8915-E to go with your taxes. If your 1099 for your disbursement has a 1 in box number 7, please download for 8915-E from www.irs.gov, or ask your tax professional. We have had several calls on this issue, and after calling both Arconic and the IRS, this is the direction we were given for our membership.

These vehicles are made in the United States or Canada by members of the UAW and Canada's Unifor union, formerly the Canadian Auto Workers (CAW). Because of the integration of vehicle production in both countries, all of the vehicles listed as made in Canada include significant UAW-made content and support the jobs of UAW members.

However, vehicles marked with a single asterisk (*) are also produced in Mexico.

All heavy-duty Chevrolet Silverados and GMC Sierras will be built in Flint, Michigan, only. Light-duty Chevrolet Silverado and GMC Sierra regular cabs are produced in Mexico only. Vehicles marked with a double asterisk (**) are the crew cab versions of the Chevrolet Silverado light-duty and GMC Sierra light-duty trucks. These are assembled by UAW members in Fort Wayne, Indiana, and also in Mexico.

When purchasing a vehicle marked with a single or double asterisk, it's important to check the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN). A VIN beginning with "1" or "4" or "5" identifies a U.S.-made vehicle; a "2" identifies a Canadian-made vehicle; a "3" identifies a vehicle made in Mexico. Not all vehicles made in the United States or Canada are built by union-represented workers. Vehicles not listed here, even if produced in the United States or Canada, are not union-made.
