Update on effects bargaining over the cancelation of the Lead Operator agreement.

The company and the Union have exchanged proposals regarding a role that would replace the Lead Operator role, the use of seniority in determining job assignments, and what classifications lead ops go to if their department doesn't have a breakback agreement. Bargaining has been slow moving and as of now there is no agreement on any of these issues. Lead Operators should strongly look at departmental bids in their departments to determine if that classification would work for their personal life. 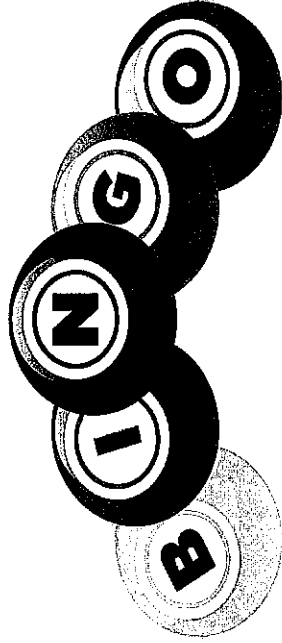

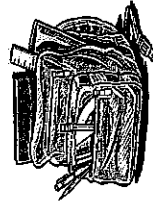
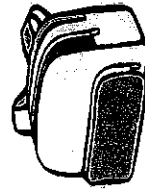

1095-C Questions

There have been a lot of questions about the amount in line 15 of the 1095-C healthcare tax document everyone received. The amount on the form is \$169 for everyone regardless of if you have single or family coverage. The instructions on the back are difficult to read, but says: Line 15. This line reports the employee required contribution, which is the monthly cost to you for the lowest cost self-only minimum essential coverage providing minimum value that your employer offered you. It then goes on to read: The amount reported on line 15 may not be the amount you paid coverage if, for example, you chose to enroll in more expensive coverage such as family coverage. This was vetted through tax professionals and the IRS.
