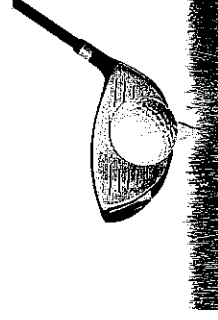

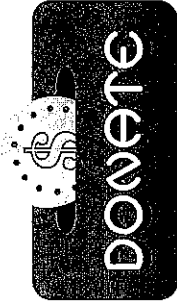
Tournament will be played as a 4 person
