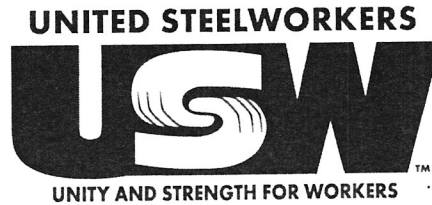

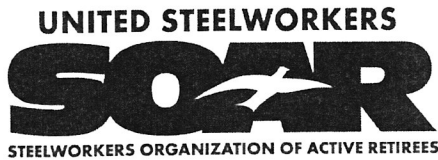

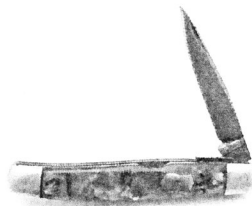


**SCAMS & FRAUD Presentation
