

SOAR minutes
December 10.2019

President Jerry Redington called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The roll call of officers was taken and all were present. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved as corrected. December 13 should have been November 13.

Treasurer Geri Hendren gave her report. The gate drop at the Titan plant brought in \$415.86 which was a good amount with fewer workers (only 231) and the many plant shutdowns and little overtime. Last meeting we collected \$204, giving a total of \$619.86 for the Salvation Army Toy collection. A motion was made to round off the donation with funds from the treasury to \$700. We adjourned at 1:50 p.m. A Christmas potluck followed during our fellowship time.
